AMETEK Aerospace & Defense Supplier Certification Requirements

As a supplier of goods and services to various government agencies AMETEK is required to report expenditures with its diverse suppliers. This data is reported to the U.S. Government as well as the Small Business Administration. Diverse suppliers include Small Disadvantaged Businesses, Woman owned, HUBZone, Veteran owned, Service Disabled Veteran owned and Historically Black Colleges and Universities. Potential and existing AMETEK suppliers are encouraged to seek out further definitions for all of the above mentioned groups by contacting the Small Business Administration (www.sba.gov), the Women Business Enterprise National Council (www.wbenc.org) or, the National Minority Supplier Development Council (www.nmsdcus.org). Note that within the definitions for each diverse group it is stipulated that business owners must be U.S. Citizens.

Definition summaries for the two largest diverse groups are as follows.

Small Disadvantaged owned businesses are defined as being at least 51% owned and operated by a Disadvantaged person as designated by the SBA. Meets size standard, SBA certified and in the Contractor Central Registration (CCR).

Women owned small business are defined as being at least 51% owned and operated by one or more women, Self Certified.

Suppliers within AMETEK's systems must provide the appropriate certifications and representations. SDB and HUBZone suppliers must acquire and maintain valid certification(s) from the Small Business Administration.

Small Disadvantaged owned and HUBZone businesses must maintain a current copy of their SBA certifications with their Procurement Representative.
